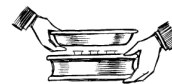

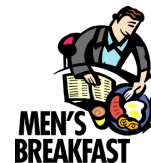
At the End of the Message

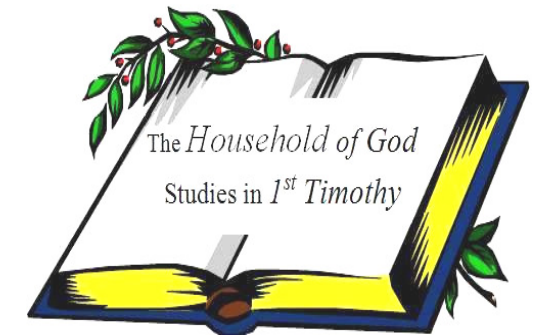
