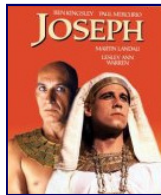

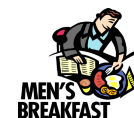
Thursday, October 25th

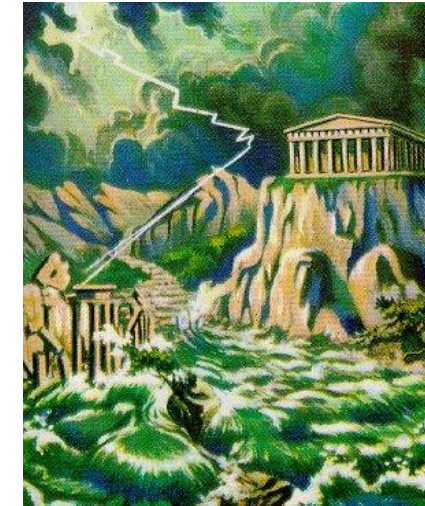
