

WELCOME TO OUR GUESTS

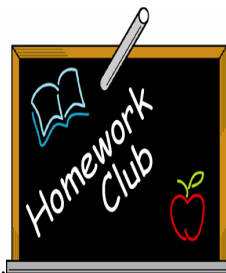
