



The month of June has been like the other four months of the year; it went by fast! This old proverb relates to a Bible passage found in 1 Cor. 3:5-9 (KJV). Here, Paul is trying to instruct members of the church, in Corinth, to grow in their faith. This letter was intended to give insight to the error of their ways. His letter was insightful, for it brought attention to the behavior that was causing its demise.

VS. 5-6 *Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers by whom ye believed, even as the Lord gave to every man? ⁶I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase.*

This passage explains how we all have a unique role in the building of God's kingdom. Paul reiterates that all their efforts were dependent upon God to bless.

V.7 *So then neither is he that planteth anything, neither he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase.*

Paul instructs the church to focus their attention on the source of power, not the instrument of power.

Vs.8-9 *Now he that planteth and he that watereth are one: and every man shall receive his own reward according to his own labour. ⁹For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building.*

Paul encourages the church to work together as a force for goodness in expanding God's work. Though we work together, our individual efforts will be examined, and for some, rewarded. We must remember our calling. We are servants of the Most High in the "fields that are white unto harvest".

If we are not careful, our church will become like the church in Corinth. It is imperative that we pay attention to the instruction that is provided in this passage. We need to look to Jesus for an example, the Holy Spirit for power and God's Holy Word for instruction. It is time for our church to leave the milk behind and move on to maturity. May God bless us as we strive to obey his word and follow in His footsteps.

Attention All Members - Our quarterly business meeting will be held on Sunday, June 9th following the morning worship service.


Your presence will be greatly appreciated as we will be going over the July to December 2013 budget.
