Since my earliest years I have always had an interest in the Bible. I faithfully attended Sunday school in my childhood. As a youth, I could recite dozens of scripture verses. In my last year of college, my dabbling in scripture became a thirst. That was the first time that I began a study of New Testament Greek. This first stab was a self-study and was not too successful. I only learned the alphabet and a few dozen words.

My second try at Greek was about ten years later in Eugene, Oregon. I was sitting in classes and learning a lot, but then I accepted a professor job in Korea. I dropped this class half way through. During this second attempt at Greek, I did learn some grammar and more vocabulary.

My third try at Greek was at seminary. This time it stuck. I love reading the original language of the New Testament and letting the words speak to my heart. After my basic Greek class, I went further and studied the book of Colossians in its original. It was a joy to read the words of Apostle Paul nearly two thousand years after he penned them. They jumped off the page at me.

Beginning on November 16, 2010, and continuing to March 27, 2012, I will be giving a series of sixteen messages taken from the wonderful book of Colossians. The theme of Colossians is "the supremacy of Christ". Paul's intent is to demonstrate that Jesus is preeminent in all things and that He fills all things. Please join us as we look through the four chapters of Colossians, verse-by-verse.

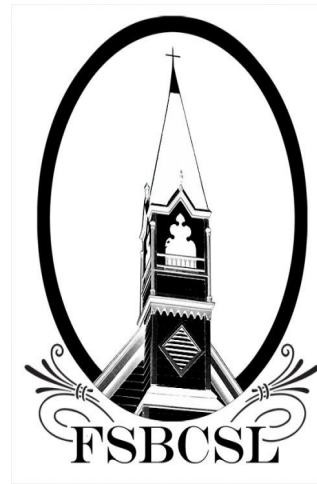

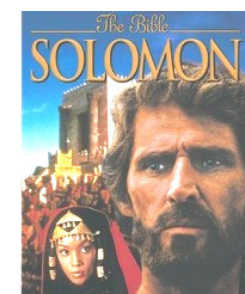
