"Boomerang Express: It All Comes Back to Jesus"

Visiting Australia was great! We learned lots of interesting facts about the "land down under." For instance, did you know that the average Australian swallows three spiders a year, and that koalas, kangaroos, and the duck-bill platypus are native only to Australia?

This year's Vacation Bible School was like most other times – challenging, rewarding, exhausting and a tremendous blessing! We averaged 54 each night, with the youth and adult classes having the highest attendance. We had a wonderful summer missionary, Seth Brill, who was out here from Mississippi and taught the youth class. He was such a blessing! We didn't have many preschoolers, which is very unusual. I'm not sure if Debbie Machetta was glad or sad over this!

Our mission offering this year will help children in Afghanistan. We had a guest missionary who came and shared about his ministry with girls and boys schools in the war-torn country. We collected over \$350 to help buy supplies and do repairs at the two schools.

On Tuesday evening we had a special emphasis on the ABC's of salvation – Admit, Believe and Confess. When Pastor Chris asked who was willing to stand up and confess that Jesus is the Son of God, eight children came forward! What a good beginning to their personal relationship with Jesus. We will be baptizing one of those children soon – praise God!

One of the things I really like is how the entire church can be a part of VBS. We have members who are able to teach, and others who can donate supplies. We are blessed with good cooks, and April who can do recreation, and pray-ers, and people who love preschoolers and children. It takes all of us working together to have a balanced and effective VBS. Thank you to EVERYONE who had a part in our "Boomerang Express" VBS.



I just returned from Africa at the end of July, spending three weeks in Butare, Rwanda. I must conclude that *Come & See Africa* employs wonderful people who fear God and serve the people of Rwanda with a joyful heart. During my time in Butare, we:

- (1) Distributed books to local school officials
- (2) Ministered to local women and children at a morning devotion time
- (3) Taught National University students in "Money Matters" & "World Religions"
- (4) Hosted a luncheon for local pastors and a supper for Student Leaders.
- (5) Presented four messages to University Students at the University stadium
- (6) Supported three local girls as they complete high school
- (7) Helped the local community with gardening and entrepreneurial projects
- (8) Preached on the local radio and in 4 local churches
- (9) Elected two new members to the board of Come and See Rwanda
- (10) Began laying the foundation stones for the LightHouse

There are two things of special interest: First, we are working on an evangelism project to present the Gospel to children and those who cannot read. We hired a local Butare artist to draw 36 panels of Salvation History through the life of Jesus Christ. We plan to publish a booklet with the 36 pictures accompanied by words in English and Kinyarwanda. Second, to help raise funds for the LightHouse, we produced a 2-minute video called "Parable of the Three Builders" This video will also show where we are in our building project.

We continue to need your prayer, participation, and financial support. We are now planning two mission trips: One led by Kim in January 2010 and one by Chris in August 2010. You are welcome to join us. You can see all the pictures and the Parable video at our web site: comeandseeafrica.org


