



Dr. Kim Hyun Deok Foreman, Professor at San Francisco State University, pastor's wife and missionary to Rwanda, passed-away Tuesday after an auto accident near the town of Gitarama, Rwanda, She was 59. Dr. Foreman was born near Soon-Chun, South Korea. After graduating from Kyung Hee University in 1973, Dr. Foreman entered a teacher-training program, taught by a Peace Corps volunteer named Chris Foreman.

After a brief engagement of one month, they were married on March 23, 1974. Dr. Foreman's first son, Zachary, was born in 1975 and her second son, Simon, was born in 1977. She received her M.A. in Curriculum and Instruction ? ESL from Drury College in Springfield, Missouri in 1980. She received her Ph.D. in Educational Technology/Educational Psychology from the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 1988. Shortly after, she was appointed an Associate Professor at San Francisco State University. She was promoted to full professor in 1996 and later served as department chair. In addition, Dr. Foreman authored many journal articles, newspaper columns on education and served as a consultant to several journals, and co-wrote a regular column with her husband in the Korea Times. She was also active in several Korean and Christian charities. She was a lifelong Christian. Her first mission to Africa was in 1998. She and her husband returned several more times before, in 2005, leading their own mission - Come & See Africa International. They broke ground on a center that will promote Christian education for the students of the University of Rwanda in Butare in June 2008. On her tenth mission to Rwanda, on July 31st, she was involved in an auto accident and was quickly rushed to King Faisal Hospital in Kigali. She passed-away peacefully on August 3rd.

Your name is KIM HYUN DEOK FOREMAN, and your name says it all. KIM is the most widespread family name in all Korea. Kim means "gold" and so you are - precious, pure and incorruptible; a wife of gold to me.

HYUN is a name given by your mother to each of her six children. Hyun means "wise" and so you are. Although at times distracted or confused - upon reflection - you always returned to wisdom; You were a wonderful counselor to me.

DEOK is your unique given name. Deok means "virtuous" and so your are - a Proverbs-31 woman par excellence. In grade school your teachers supposed "Hyun Deok" to be a boy, for what girl could carry a name like "wise & virtuous? But you, my love, carried it well for 59 years Your moral compass kept me going in a heavenly direction.

FOREMAN is the name that you adopted with joy. Foreman is my family name, and from our wedding day you understood that by becoming one flesh with me, it was right for you to share one name with me. I marvel at how you acquired my family name, yet cleverly, you maintained your own identity.

You are truly unique. There can be only one KIM HYUN DEOK FOREMAN is the annals of history. Perhaps your one-of-a-kind name will help me to locate you in the Kingdom of God and in the reign of Christ. I will be looking for that remarkable woman of gold, wisdom and virtue, who for 36 years was my earthly companion and of one flesh with me. I am so grateful to God that you did not suffer pain in your last moments. I miss you so much already My heart is breaking. I love you and I am confident that I will see you again.
