Please read carefully the following information about your summer reading assignment. Please follow the directions precisely. You will be tested over this during the first week of school. Do not wait until the last minute to read. Even though *Prince Caspian* is a short book, you will not understand it if you rush through the reading. Your assignments are as follows:

- As you read *Prince Caspian* you will need to **select 15 words** that are new to you and fill out the necessary vocabulary worksheet that goes along with this assignment. As outlined on the worksheet, you must list the chapter number, the page number, the definition, and a complete sentence that demonstrates proper use of the word according to the following example:

- After completing *Prince Caspian*, you will need to write a 2-page summary of the book as if you were retelling the story. Be sure to include only the necessary details.
- You will need to be prepared to turn in both assignments on or before **Friday, August 16**
- You will be required to take the AR test over the book ASAP.
- We also ask that incoming 6th graders **practice cursive writing** over the summer. We have posted a list of simple Bible verses you may choose from to complete this assignment titled "Bible Verses Students Can Write in Cursive". **Please choose at least 12 (or more if you like) verses to write and turn in the first day of school.** A sample copy of cursive writing paper is attached.
