Dear Sisters & Brothers,

Forty Days (plus 7 Sundays), otherwise known as Lent 2007 were highlights for Prospect United Methodist Church. During those few short weeks the church celebrated at Worship, Witness and growing in our faith.

Highlights of Worship included our Ash Wednesday and Maundy Thursday services. Worship each Sunday and a High Day in Easter Worship wrapped up our 40 days plus 8 Sundays. Our Maundy Thursday service was a great learning experience as we read the scriptures and experienced a Passover ritual similar to what Jesus experienced when the Communion Service was instituted. Easter arrived with bitter cold and an attendance of 45 at the Lake. Worship followed with an attendance of 126. Almost 150 individuals attended at least one of our Easter Worship experience.

Witness experiences included the giving of luggage to UMFS. Prospect UMC filled the bed of my S-10 Chevrolet pickup. We also increased our Communion Offering to share with others with the giving of staples. The third witness experience was the Lenten Self-Denial Offering. We have received enough gifts to purchase an upgraded copier and the purchase of a new computer and accessories. Thanks for you giving.

Growing our faith has occurred as we have wrestled with Bible Study and does the Sunday School meet the needs of this day and time. We did start two new Bible Study Groups (Sunday Morning at 8 a.m. and Wednesday mornings at 10 a.m.) with a combined average attendance of 15. People are responding well to the opportunity to study God's word.
