READ IT!

(VERSE OF THE DAY)

"Therefore, since we have been made right in God's sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us" (Romans 5:1).

DO IT!

(SERVING)

When we see how much we all need Jesus' intervention in our lives, it helps to put in perspective the way we feel about "enemies"—people who are like thorns in our side. When you come across one of those people this week, love the way Jesus loves and look for a simple way to encourage or serve your "enemy."

PRAY IT!

(PRAY FOR...)

Think of a specific friend, and then pray, "Jesus, help my friend to live a life that pleases you.

Help my friend to say yes to things that are good and no to things that are not."

LOVE IT!

(GETTING CLOSER TO JESUS)

LIVE IT!

(WORSHIP)

In 1 Samuel 15:22 the prophet
Samuel tells Saul, the king

more pleasing to God than
sacrifice. When you're tempted
to do something you know is
disobedient today (and you will
be), stop and choose the path of
obedience instead, as an act of
worship.
