### **Course Listing for the 2020 MBSC of MO Virtual Annual Session** **(October 12<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020 for class time instruction)**

**1112 Survey of Revelations (Phase 4) Rev. Everett Hannon**  
**Dept. of Biblical Studies**

Explore the book of Revelation, with emphases on authorship, date, theme, and recipients. Discuss the prophetic themes, symbols, and interpretations of various revelations.

**7005 Christian Evangelism (Phase 3) Rev. Nathaniel Griffin**  
**Dept. of Church Growth and Discipleship**

Teach the basics steps in developing a program of evangelism. Discover the appropriate Scriptures to use, and the methods, techniques, and media best suited for witnessing to nonbelievers.

**SP0002 Hermeneutics Rev. Tony Johnson**  
**Specialization Education Studies Program**

This course should help the students to know and use proper tools for biblical interpretation. Students will be introduced to different forms of writings in the Scriptures as well as how they are to be understood in both historical and contemporary contexts.

**SP0004 The Centrality of Christ in the Scriptures Dr. Alfred White**  
**Specialization Education Studies Program**

This course focuses on the Christ of the Scriptures. Students will examine the Scriptures, from Genesis to Revelation, to see how the biblical narrative has prefigured Jesus, the Son of God, as the central focus of the Bible.

**SP0005 Christian Apologetics**  
**Specialization Education Studies Program**

**Rev. Curtis Williams**

This study will focus on the importance of students' being able to defend their faith at all times. This course will help students to focus on their own faith and, at the same time, understand enough of other belief systems to be able to effectively engage in evangelism and outreach.

**SP0019 Overcoming Leadership Distress**  
**Specialization Education Studies Program**

**Dr. Donald Ray McNeal**

This course looks at both the causes and effects of leadership distress. Students will investigate ways of avoiding negative stresses that will nullify effective leadership and program success.
