A Note from the Pastor:

MISSIONS EDITION

Did you know that through this coronavirus crisis those who have continued to faithfully give to the ministry at FBC Friona have had a gospel impact across the world? That's right, we may not have been able to meet in person, but you have been able to support gospel work from Friona to the ends of the earth. FBC Friona is dedicated to staying obedient to Jesus' words in Acts 1:8, "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." Here are some ways that we have been able to support gospel work through the virus crisis.

Lesotho, Africa—missionaries Stan and Angie Burleson returned to the US many weeks earlier than planned to ensure they would be here for their daughter's wedding in late May, and we sent \$1075 to help them with travel expenses. We also helped one of the Lesotho pastors with \$1050 to repair his home and shop so he can continue to care for his family, earn a living and be a blessing to his community in sharing the gospel. Pastor Neo has been a great blessing in the gospel work in Lesotho for our mission teams and the Burlesons.

India—we continue to support Pastor Srinivas monthly with \$400, but we also sent an extra \$400 To help minister in India during the virus. India has been on lockdown for many weeks and Srinivas and his fellow pastors were able to buy food to help feed needy people and minister the gospel.

Mexico—we sent \$800 to Pastor Naftali in Aldama, Mexico to assist with food relief among those who are needy and hungry where he lives. This allowed his church to

assist people with basic needs during a time when day labor has slowed or ceased, which is causing great hardship on many in the world.

Brian and Hope Wiseman with Training Leaders International—Although the virus caused Brian to come back early from pastors' trainings in Liberia and cancel travel to Central America, his ministry has not ceased. He and the TLI staff are busy using modern technology to train church leaders and plan ahead in the midst of uncertainty regarding global travel and accessibility to the places they have been training pastors. We support Brian and Hope with \$450 monthly.

The Hope Welcome Center—this ministry of our local Baptist Association provides free room and food to people coming to visit their families who are in prison in the Amarillo area. It is located just south of the prisons in Amarillo and we send \$50 per month to support this work.

Chosen People Ministries—this ministry focuses on sharing Christ with the Jewish people in their homeland of Israel. We support Eugene Lempert with \$100 a month as he ministers in Israel to help Jewish people come to know Christ.

*******The mission support mentioned above comes from 5% of our regular offering that we set aside to fund mission work and our teams when they are sent out.**

Cooperative Program Giving to The Southern Baptist of Texas Convention—We give 13% of the general offering to support mission work in our state through the SBTC. The SBTC keeps 45% of this to start, support and strengthen churches in Texas. The other 55% is sent by them to the national Southern Baptist Convention where that money is used to send and train

missionaries through NAMB and IMB, support the finest and largest seminaries in the world, plant churches, and provide resources for the Church.

North American Mission Board—NAMB is our Southern Baptist entity that organizes, supports and leads in mission work in North America. Through the recent Annie Armstrong Easter Offering we were able to give \$4405.86 to support church planting and gospel work in North America.

International Mission Board—IMB is the branch of the Southern Baptist Convention that organizes, trains and supports our over 3500 Southern Baptist missionaries serving around the globe. Our church's regular support of the IMB allows us to be a part of the gospel going forth across the globe.

Amendment to the Church Bylaws and Constitution

In the May 31 business meeting, an amendment to the Church Bylaws and Constitution was presented to the church that would govern updating the membership rolls of the church. The below amendment will be discussed and voted on for approval in the regularly scheduled business meeting in July.

Section V. Updating the Membership Roles of the Church

When the need arises for the rolls of the church to be updated so that an accurate record of the members can be maintained and cared for, the church will proceed as follows. First, the church must approve by a 2/3 vote of members present at a church business meeting to take action to update the church membership rolls. Next, the church must elect a committee to lead in updating the rolls of the church. This committee will consist of the pastor, youth and education pastor, deacon chairman, church clerk and three other church members elected by the church. The task of the committee is to contact those on the church rolls in a redemptive manner so that the committee can bring a report and recommendations back to the church at a business meeting in regard to updating the church roll. The church will approve or disapprove the committee's recommendations based on a majority vote of church members present at a regular business meeting or a special called business meeting for this purpose.
