If you are a Baptist, and have been baptized by immersion in another church of like faith and order, then this church may accept you upon promise of a letter of recommendation from that church.

By Statement

A Baptist may join this church, when it may not be possible to obtain a letter from the former church, by statement of having been baptized by immersion in another Baptist church of like faith and order.

If you are a Christian, but belong to another denomination and desire to join this church, then you may be received by baptism, if you desire to embrace the faith and practice of Southern Baptists.



"The Joy of Spiritual Contentment"


