**Hearing Loop is Now Activated** – For the hearing impaired, a hearing loop is now in place around the perimeter of the Sanctuary (floor level) and Bullock-Matthews Room. Anyone sitting in these areas, and who has a telecoil, or T-coil in their hearing aid or Cochlear implant will be able to access the inducted sound coming from the loop. Activated hearing devices will not only restore volume to the listener, but also frequencies that the listener might struggle to normally hear. A small number of wireless headsets are available on a first-come, first-serve basis for those who might need them and do not have the proper hearing aids. Please contact our Ushers for a wireless headset. Since this is the first Sunday we are using the hearing loop, adjustments will need to be made by our sound team to make sure everything is running smoothly.
