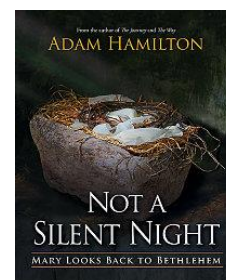
**SUNDAY, JULY 12** - During our 11:00 AM worship service we will have a Commissioning Prayer for our youth attending Passport.
