FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE . .

July was an eventful month for the Jonesboro Heights Baptist Church family!


Along with Vacation Bible School for children early in the month and for adults late in the month, we elected officers, teachers, and other leaders and workers, elected three new deacons for the 2011-2014 term, adopted the new budget for the 2011-2012 church year, sent a team of youth and adults to the Passport missions camp in Macon, Georgia, and sent David and Heather Webb to serve Christ in India. What a month!

God has been moving among us in some marvelous ways. Our new budget has continued the strategic increase in budgeted missions giving. *City on a Hill Ministries* has added a new dimension to our embodying the presence of Christ to the world. This fall we will be looking at how we need to proceed with the next steps of *Mission Jonesboro*. Many of those who helped lead the children's VBS have come into our church family over the past year to three years. We are seeing good progress in the area of family ministry under Richard Wood's leadership, and our music ministry continues to be strong under Ronnie Byrd's leadership.

With the Webbs' transition, our Personnel Committee has been searching for a new Church Administrator. Please keep this search in your prayers, as this role has become a critical component in enabling the overall ministry of our church. We are grateful that Richard Wood will be taking on some of the most crucial administrator responsibilities until a new administrator is in place. The Personnel Committee is working hard and hopes to recommend a candidate in the near future.

While July has been a full month, August will be significant, too.

Jo Ann and I will be going on a mission trip to Belize, where I will teach in the August session of the Baptist Bible School of Belize (this will be my second opportunity to teach there). Jo Ann will be "invigilating" (proctoring) exams and helping with other needs. The Baptist Bible School of Belize offers basic theological training to pastors and other church workers from churches in the Baptist Association of Belize. We will be away for ten days (including one Sunday). Please be in prayer for us as we travel and as we work in Belize, and for the students. Many of them make great sacrifices to come to the Baptist Training Center three weeks out of the year along with working through study books in between sessions.




FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE . . . (continued)

In some ways it's hard to believe that it was six years ago now that my family and I moved to Sanford and began our journey with you. Much has happened during that time, both in our family and in our church family. We've been through a lot together. We are grateful for the support you have shown us in our times of grief when loved ones have died. We are grateful for how God is working among us and blessing us. And we look forward to how he will continue to work as we serve Christ together in the years to come. So as we begin our seventh year of ministry together, my prayer is that we will continue to follow Christ fearlessly into the future as we seek to embody Christ's presence to Sanford and the world.

**Announcing City on a Hill Ministries
First Mission Trip Opportunity**

- **What:** A mission trip to India. We will conduct ministry projects with children and engage in "as you go" street ministry with homeless families in at least two cities.
- **When:** December 27, 2011 to January 9, 2012
- **Who:** Adults ages 18 and up feeling a call to serve God in India
- **Cost Range:** \$2,500- \$2,900, includes airfare, accommodation, in country transport, supplies for ministry projects, and food. The final cost of the trip will be dependent on airfare rates when tickets are purchased. NOTE: Passport and visa fees are not included in the trip cost. (Passport= \$135, Visa= ~\$100)
- **How to Sign-up:** Fill out a Team Member Information Sheet and submit a deposit of \$500 by August 15th. **Team Information Sheets are available in the church office.**

I would like to share a short story I found in "Mary's Way" by Peggy Tabor Millin: "In Every Encounter, we leave something of Ourselves with Others".

I was on a train on a rainy day. The train was slowing down to pull into a station. For some reason I became intent on watching the raindrops on the window. Two separate drops, pushed by the wind, merged into one for a moment and and divided again - each carrying with it a part of the other.

I saw this metaphor many years ago and it is one of my most vivid memories. I realized then we never touch people so lightly that we do not leave a trace. Our state of being matters to those around us, so we need to become conscious of what we unintentionally share so we can share with intention.

God has gifted us so we can help others learn of God's riches hidden in Christ . No joy can surpass that of seeing our labor for Christ produce results in the lives of others. Will you leave a trace of Christ with the people you encounter?


