### Becoming a Follower of Christ

Those who have not put their faith in Him are separated from God by their sin, a separation that continues in eternity in hell if they die without Christ.

Trusting Jesus involves recognizing your need of Him, asking Him to forgive you, and committing yourself to Him as your Lord. The Christian life is about following Jesus, getting to know Him, and becoming like Him. Once you trust Christ, being baptized expresses your commitment publicly. Becoming a part of a local congregation helps you to know and serve Christ as a part of His people, the family of God.

*What year did the church become Jonesboro Heights Baptist Church?* In 1947 when Jonesboro and Sanford merged and Jonesboro became Jonesboro Heights, we changed our name to Jonesboro Heights Baptist Church.

*In 1941 the pastor of JHBC served three other churches. Do you know the names of those churches?* In 1941, just before Pearl Harbor, we had 318 members and Rev. Joel Frank Stegall served Jonesboro Heights, Vass, Ephesus and Cool Springs churches during the 4 years of World War II.
