"When a person leaves, he/she leaves behind some little scrap of his/her heart... It's the same with a place to which one is going. Only then they send a scrap of their hearts ahead." This is a quote by American writer and theologian Frederick Buechner. Today, Rev. Jeff Roberts gives his last sermon as Interim Pastor at JHBC. In his sermon today, he will share about his experience here and give us a challenge as we move forward when our new pastor comes in March.
