FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE . .

It's hard to believe it's already summer. It seems as though 2011 is flying by even faster than previous years.


We've already seen so much happen this year. Of course the defining event so far this year for so many in our area is the April 16 tornado and its aftermath. Like so many other areas of our country, we saw extensive damage. While the cleanup phase is now pretty much complete, the repair and rebuilding stage will take much longer.

But we've seen some very good things happening in our church this year. We've had a number of new families to join in recent months. We have welcomed Rev. Richard Wood and his wife Beth as we called him to serve as our Associate Pastor for Family Ministry. Richard is settling in, getting to know JHBC and our members, and doing a great job.

That call was followed by our congregation's decision to become the sending church for David and Heather Webb as they join God on His mission in India. This is a new approach for us, and a defining decision and commitment for our church. Since they will be our missionaries, vitally connected with our church, they will be an extension of JHBC in India to embody Christ's presence there. I am very excited about this step, and am looking forward to how God is going to work in this endeavor. Pray for David and Heather as they are preparing to leave for India on July 19. David's last official day as our Church Administrator will be July 15. After that, he and Heather will officially be JHBC missionaries.

This transition leads to another prayer request. Our Personnel Committee has already begun working on finding the person to fill the role of Church Administrator after David and Heather make their transition to India. Pray for God's guidance for the Personnel Committee in their search, and that God would bring them together with the right candidate who has the needed spiritual gifts, skill set, and understanding of the balance of business and kingdom principles and practices for this important position. We know that since God is leading David to India, He is already preparing someone for this role. Pray that God will bring us together with that person as quickly as possible so that the transition can be as smooth, orderly, and effective as possible.

On another note, I recently returned from the annual conference of the Baptist History and Heritage Society, which met at Dallas Baptist University in Dallas, Texas. This year's theme was "Baptists and Education." I was privileged to present a paper to a breakout session about teaching as ministry. My paper was about my and Jo Ann's beloved former professor Dr. Donald Keyser and how he approached his 38 years of teaching at Campbell as his pastoral ministry. It's important for us to remember our Baptist story. That story is about individuals and groups of followers of Jesus who have been and are of the Baptist persuasion. The Baptist History and Heritage Society does an excellent job of helping to compile and tell that story. I am grateful for that work. If you have an interest in our history and heritage as Baptists, I would urge you to consider joining the Society.

As a member you will receive the journal *Baptist History and Heritage*, published three times a year. Next year's meeting will be hosted by Campbell University and held at the First Baptist Church of Raleigh.



There will be more opportunities in the recovery efforts as families repair or replace their homes. There are still many other opportunities in the community right around us that we continue to need to address through Mission Jonesboro.

As we continue to move forward, I pray that JHBC will always be ready and willing to take the next step God calls us to take as we follow Jesus into the future. God is at work among us! As we trust Him and follow Him, He will work in wonderful ways to fulfill His will and purpose in ways that may be unique to our situation. After all, as our recent children's musical, which the children and leaders presented so well, put it, we must "follow *His* steps in *our* shoes."

CITY ON A HILL MINISTRIES

Thank you to everyone who has continued to offer encouragement and prayers as we prepare to depart for India in July. We want to announce that we are planning for a mission team to come serve with us very soon!

Here is what we are planning so far:

What: A mission trip to India. We will conduct ministry projects with children and engage in "as you go" street ministry with homeless families in at least two Indian cities.

When: December 27, 2011 to January 9, 2012 **Who:** Adults ages 18 and up feeling a call to serve God in India

Cost: \$2,500- \$2,900 (depending on airfare) **Team Size:** Up to 10

How to Sign-up: Fill out a Team Member Information Sheet and submit a deposit of \$500 by August 15th.
Team Information Sheets are available in the church office.

In May, we visited two churches that are potential partner churches for the City on a Hill Ministry: Hillcrest Baptist in Suffolk, VA and Beaver Creek Baptist in Cameron, NC. We also shared about our plans with First Baptist Church of Elizabeth City as Heather delivered the message for their 225th Anniversary service. We were blessed to have an opportunity to extend greetings from JHBC to other churches and share about our upcoming ministry in India.

Thank you again for all of the encouragement you all have continued to give to us.


