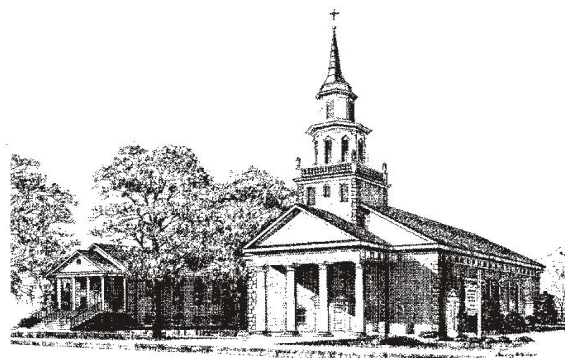
## AN INVITATION
