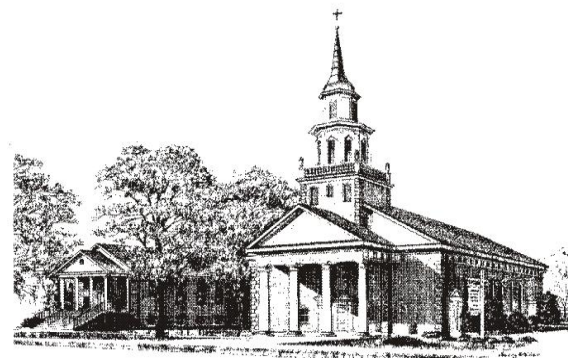
### **AN INVITATION**
