Proposal: To Solve the drainage issue at the Town of Caton Park along the north side of the Entry Drive.

Issue: At present the land is so wet from a combination of run-off and natural spring water. It can't be mowed, or basically even walked on.

Project Details: Hand dig drainage ditch and catch basin locations. Install catch basins, drainage pipe in trenches and refill trench. The work will have to be done by hand, due to the extreme wetness of the slope. The surface will not hold any piece of equipment. Additionally, if done by hand, no stake out will be required as not power tools will be used, and now depth will exceed 12 inches. I've wanded the proposed area with a metal detector and found no trace of wires or metal items.
