WHO'S MISSING AT THE BANQUET TABLE?



Jesus tells the story in Luke 14 of a man who is preparing a **huge banquet** and sends out his servant to let the people he's invited know it's time to come. But the people all come up with various kinds of excuses why they can't come. When the master hears about those who've turned down his invitation, he tells his servant to open things up, to search the highways and byways for anybody who will come.

As we move through the summer, many of our churches are seeing children, youth, and adults who don't normally attend their church attend events like children's camp, VBS, youth camp, a block party or some other kind of event connected with the church. They are **people who've been missing** at the Master's banquet table, and whom He calls us to invite. Some of them may reject the invitation, but there are many just waiting for an invitation.

The last time we researched the degree of spiritual lostness in the area encompassed by our association, we estimated there are **over 40,000 people** who don't regularly attend church. They would fill all the seats in many college football stadiums! Who are those people around your church and community? Who are those people in your neighborhood?

Have you ever thought of mapping out where the unchurch people in your community live and strategically praying and thinking through how to reach them for Christ? If not, **why not be the catalyst** God uses in your church to seek and find those waiting to be invited to the Master's banquet table? Studies have shown time and again that unchurched people are much more open to a personal invitation than we think!



One resource I've discovered to assist in knowing, praying for, and building bridges of friendship with your neighbors is the ministry called **Bless Every Home** (https://blesseveryhome.com). All you have to do is sign up and give them your address, then they send you a map that shows you who your neighbors are and guides you through a process that begins with praying for them, meeting them, building a relationship, and telling the Good News of Jesus' invitation to trust Him for salvation. Imagine the impact if all our church members were consistently praying for and building friendships with their unchurched neighbors!

May each of us be bearers of Good News!




