



Details for Team Members

Objectives:

- 1) To partner with Life Connection Church in reaching out to the community around Gladestone Elementary, where it will begin holding services later in the spring; there are people from many different countries in the area--Ethiopia, Somalia, Syria, Sudan, West African countries, plus several Central American countries
- 2) To partner with couples who've moved into NE Downtown with the intent of sharing the Gospel with people from various unreached people groups, including Afghans and Kurds

Team Member Age Limit: 16 and up, unless accompanied by parent, youth minister, or pastor

Mandatory Team Preparation Meeting: Sunday March 10, 4 pm at CSBA Building

Lodging: Connection Point Church in Raytown, Kansas City area

- We will be staying in the area of the church where the youth meet and using their classrooms for sleeping quarters
- Each team member will need to bring an air mattress or cot and linens or sleeping bag plus towels and toiletries
- There are multi-stall restrooms for changing clothes
- There are showers in the locker rooms of the church gymnasium

Schedule (March 16-22):

- Saturday morning: depart from CSBA Parking Lot in Enid

- Saturday late afternoon: arrive at Connection Point and get settled in
- Sunday morning:
 - Clear out sleeping quarters at Connection Point in preparation for Sunday School there later that morning
 - Attend worship service at Life Connection Church in NE Downtown KC
- Sunday afternoon:
 - Orientation with Life Connection Pastor Chris Seay
- Monday and Tuesday:
 - Canvas the community around Gladestone Elementary where Life Connection will begin meeting later in the spring
- Wednesday:
 - Orientation with Seth and Emily Gillam, who are seeking to reach Afghan and Kurdish people for Christ
 - Survey large apartment complex where Afghans live to help locate people interested in a Citizenship Class
 - Survey neighborhood where many Kurds live for same reason
- Thursday:
 - Sightseeing in KC
 - Activity TBD
 - Provide childcare for couples hosting an event for Afghan and Kurds celebrating Nowruz (Persian New Year)
- Friday morning: depart KC
- Friday afternoon: return to Enid

Spending Money: Bring enough for 3 meals out (2 on road going and coming and 1 for supper on Saturday when we arrive in KC)
