8. To help maintain a Christian spirit in the cabin and to take any problems to the proper persons.
9. I will refrain from any activity which causes discomfort to others, or damages beds or equipment in the cabin.
10. It is understood that my failure to comply with these rules may mean that I will be asked to leave the Assembly at my own expense.
11. I will provide a completed Camper Health Form with this application.

POTTAWATOMIE-LINCOLN BAPTIST ASSOCIATION CHILDREN'S CAMP Falls Creek - General Rules Information

1. **ORGANIZATION AND SPONSORS.** An administrative team will be set up for the organization of camp. The general camp director is responsible for the conduct and administration of the group. His word is final on all matters. Each person attending is expected to give cooperation and respect for those in charge. Each church sending campers to the assembly for the association camp will be asked to have a sponsor for boys and one for girls attending from their church, or a previous arrangement made with another church to be the sponsor for those attending. **All sponsors and overnight adult guests must submit a background check verification form at the ACC office at Falls Creek.**
2. **FACILITIES.** Our association rents a 80 bed capacity cabin equipped with double bunk beds and mattresses and is set up in dormitory style. The Cabin will accommodate 40 boys and 40 girls. It is necessary for each camper to bring their own pillow, bedding and personal items.
3. **RESERVATIONS.** Reservations should be made through the Pottawatomie-Lincoln Baptist association office. An application blank will need to be completed by each person and signed. **A registration fee of \$45.00 must accompany the application** and be submitted **no later than 14 days prior to the Monday of camp week.**
4. **ONE DAY GUESTS.** Those who come for a brief period of time should make reservations through the Association Secretary for meals and/or beds in advance.
5. **ASSEMBLY RULES AND REGULATIONS.** The rules and regulations of our cabin are those of the assembly. Each person **MUST** attend scheduled class periods and worship services unless excused by the director. Each person is required to be on time for meals, for the evening devotions and to observe bedtime rules. Falls Creek is a Christian camp. Those attending should keep in mind that proper dress for a Christian should be the kind of dress worn at the camp. While on Falls Creek grounds campers may not wear apparel that exposes the midriff, is extremely tight fitting or has writing on the back of pants or shorts. Apparel may not display or promote tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances or inappropriate language or pictures. All shorts and dresses should be modest length. At Falls Creek, modest shorts are generally defined as shorts that have at least a five inch inseam or longer and dresses and skirts should be four inches from the top of the knee or longer. Slits in dresses and skirts should also be modest in length. Shirts/tops must have at least three inches across the shoulder. A robe must be worn to and from the swimming pool for those swimming. **Use of tobacco in any form is not permitted in the cabin or on the campgrounds!**
6. **REGARDING THE ASSOCIATIONAL CABIN.** Water fights, shave cream fights, etc. are forbidden at all times at Falls Creek and thus will not be permitted in the cabin. Each sponsor is expected to inform each camper to refrain from marking on the walls, doors, ceiling, etc. of the cabin or damaging ceiling tiles. Those caught doing so will be responsible for paying for repair of damage. Your cooperation will be greatly appreciated in helping keep the cabin clean and in good shape. Adult sponsors are responsible for the behavior of their campers.
7. **TRANSPORTATION/INSURANCE.** Each church will be responsible for the transportation of their group to and from Falls Creek. The assembly insurance, included in the \$45.00 gate fee paid by each person, covers each camper from the time he leaves home until he returns home. It also pays for medical care while at Falls Creek.
8. **COSTS PER CAMPER:**

Please use ONE church check when paying PLBA and ONE church check when paying ACC.

*Gate fee is to be paid **at Falls Creek** by each church. Please do not turn it in with the application or take to the cabin.

**Food costs include 9 meals, snacks and drinks each day.

9. **RECREATION.** Afternoons are given to organized recreation and play.
