Personal Testimony:

I was born in Harrah, Oklahoma & was raised in church all my life. My parents were members of the Catholic Church in Harrah. Not only did I attend the Catholic Church, but for the 1st 6 grades I attend the Catholic school. I was very active in the church, from serving as an altar boy to reading for the Mass. It was great growing up in a small town but it also had its challenges. I started drinking at a very early age. Eventually the drinking lead to drug abuse & a wild life style that lead to all sorts of problems for me & my family.

On April 26, 1976 as a college student I accepted Christ as my Lord & Savior. It was at a revival meeting that was held at the First Baptist Church in Harrah. Not long after that I felt God's calling on my life. I started slow because I was not sure this was something I wanted to do. I had my life planned out & this was not part of it. I slowly got involved with working in the youth department in our church & eventually was called into the youth ministry. I spent the next several years running from God's call to go to seminary.

After 10 years I finally surrendered & packed up my family & we moved to Kansas City to Midwestern Bapt. Theological Seminary to continue my education. Upon graduation in May of 1993 we were appointed by the Home Mission Board (NAMB) as church planters in Western Kansas. After 3 years in Western Kansas, the next several years were spent pastoring churches in Seiling, Porter, & Chattanooga, Oklahoma. We served as the Director of Missions in Fairfield Illinois before moving back to Oklahoma where we served as pastor of FBC in Leedey. God called us back to the DOM ministry in 2013 at Sans Bois Baptist Association until recent retirement.

My heart is to help struggling churches to reach their potential in Christ. While in Illinois I worked with 3 churches that were about to shut their doors because of problems in the church & attendance that started declining due to problems. We were able to help them turn around & they are presently doing very well & are a positive impact in their community. The same happened in SBBA a church closed because of a lack of people to attend. After 18 months a healthy church came along side to 'mother' the struggling church. Today it is doing very well for the area.
