

# “How To Live In Perennial Revival”

## Psalm 85:8-13

Introduction of Psalm 85:

- Acknowledge God’s work in the past (vv.1-3)
- Accept God’s work in the present (vv. 4-7)
- Anticipate God’s work in the future (vv. 8-13)

(Four reminders on how to move from here to revival:)

- I. REDISCOVER GOD’S WORD (v. 8 “I will hear what God the Lord will say, for He will speak...to His people...”)
  - God Still Speaks!
- II. REVERE GOD’S WORK (v. 9 “...His salvation is near to those who fear Him, that His glory may dwell in the land.”)
  - God Still Saves!
- III. REALIGN WITH GOD’S WAYS (vv. 10-11 “Loving-kindness and truth have met together...” ie. grace and truth. “Righteousness and peace have kissed each other.”)
  - God Still Sanctifies!
- IV. RECOMMIT TO GOD’S WILL (vv. 12-13 “...our land will yield its produce. Righteousness will go before Him and will make His footsteps into a way.”)
  - God Still Sends!

Conclusion “Will You not Yourself revive us again that your people may rejoice in You?
