

“Passing The Final Exam”

II Corinthians 5:10

1. For Believers 2. For Certain 3. For All (10 a)
 - I. It is the same exam for everyone.
(each one gets the same test)
 - II. It is a comprehensive exam. (Luke 12:2-3)
(It's over all the material)
 - III. It is a required exam. (v. 10b)
(Each one must take the final)
 - IV. How well we do on the final will reflect how well we did on the pop quizzes. (Romans 2:16)
 - V. Test questions will be both objective and subjective
(I Cor. 3:13)
(Listening, matching, yes/no, essay) (John 6:63)
 - VI. The final will determine whether or not we read the text.
(The author and authorship is clear)
Everything on the test is in the text
 - VII. It is an exam for which we must prepare.
(Hear, read, study, meditate, memorize)
 - VIII. It is an exam which is administered by the “Professor” Himself. (Romans 14:10-12)
(No subs, assistants, apprentices, graders)
 - IX. We will never pass the final if we've never attended class.
(You have to go to class)
 - X. For this exam everyone has access to a tutor. (i.e. Jesus)
(Meet with one who has taken the course and passed the final before you)
 - XI. It is an oral exam (Romans 14:10-12)
(One on one with the Professor)
 - XII. It is impossible to cheat on this exam (I Cor. 4:5)
