Please read the following information. This is the Planning Committee's Report and Recommendations given to the Executive Board April 1, 2021. These recommendations were approved. You will be hearing more in the coming days about the implementation of these. The key will be 'your' involvement. Please use these as a guide for prayer. In your prayers ask the Lord how you may be used to fulfil these ministries. There will be a place for you to serve.

Planning Committee Report and Recommendations

A motion was made at the Annual Meeting on September 21, 2020 to form a planning committee. The committee was to be appointed by the moderator. The moderator presented a list of names for approval by the Executive Board on October 1, 2020. The list was approved, and the committee consists of the following:

Kevin Carter (Kennett First), Ex-Officio Steven Scherer, chair (Kennett First)

The planning committee met on ten occasions to evaluate, discuss, and plan for the future of the association. Based on our discussions, we would like to make the following five recommendations to be voted upon by the Executive Board:

1) Align annual budget/expenses with actual revenue

- -Incrementally reduce budget over next three years to \$120,000-130,000
- -Current budget is \$172,000; each year our expenses exceed our income
- -We have consistently relied on income from church closings, estate gifts,
- etc. to stay cover budget deficits
- -A budget of \$120,000-130,000 is in line with our revenue from churches and camp

2) Form a Personnel Team

-A team of three to five individuals will be appointed by the moderator and presented to the Executive Board for approval

- -Team will be asked to formulate a job description, a clarification of benefits, and evaluate housing and financial needs of staff
- -Team will periodically meet with Director of Missions for support and encouragement

3) Take steps to make camp (more) solvent

- -Camp is one of our greatest assets but also operates at a major loss each year (\$10,000 loss in 2020; \$28,000 loss in 2016)
- -Fixed costs of camp (utilities, mowing, regular maintenance, etc.) is upwards of \$15,000
- -Must generate more funds to help offset the loss or budget for loss

4) Evaluate and update our constitution

- -Create a constitution team to make necessary and appropriate updates/changes to our constitution
- -Upon completion of their work, this team will make recommendations to the Executive Board
- -Possible updates: changing the budget year, switching the months of the annual meeting/fall Executive Board meeting, allowing Executive Board meetings to occur virtually, the possibility of Executive Board members being able to vote via email, and incorporating changes that will occur if recommendation #5 below is approved


