

RULES FOR USE OF CAMP GROUND

Black River Baptist Association Churches

- Churches or groups in the Black River Baptist Association wishing to use the camp grounds (except for events scheduled on the Association calendar) should contact the Association office.
- Churches are asked to leave the campgrounds and buildings in the same condition as they found them including properly disposing of trash in the proper containers.
- Each church will be responsible for providing insurance for their cabin, maintenance, and properly winterizing it.
- Camp will be used on Sunday only for worship during traditional worship hours and only appropriately at other times on Sunday and Wednesday evenings during Church prayer meeting or Bible Study.
- If you need to use the cabin of another Church, please obtain permission from that Church. The Association will help you with that if needed. Please make sure the cabin is left in the same condition it was before it was borrowed and return the key.
- The gate will be closed at 10:00 pm.
- No loitering will be permitted on the grounds.
- No unauthorized vehicles including ATV's will be permitted on the grounds.
- No alcoholic beverages or use of tobacco products will be permitted on the grounds.
- No fireworks or firearms allowed on campgrounds.
- Please refrain from being on the ditch bank.

Non Black River Baptist Association Churches

- Use of the camp may be permitted for churches outside of the Black River Baptist Association pending the approval of the Director of Missions and the Camp Committee with special rules which do not apply to BRBA churches. Use must be coordinated through the Association office and cannot interfere with previously scheduled Association events.
- There is nonrefundable charge of \$25 per 24hr period for camp use for SBC and Non SBC (visiting) churches.
- There is a \$50 deposit per use for visiting churches which will be refunded after their use of the camp if

no damages were incurred.

- Any damages caused while under the use of a visiting church is responsibility of that group to fix regardless of the dollar amount.
- Any visiting church wanting to use the Kitchen facilities will not be allowed to use the dishwasher.
- If a sound system is needed by the visiting church then they will have to provide their own.
- If the pool is used by the visiting church then they must provide a certified life guard while swimmers are in the pool. Certification of the life guard must be provided to the Association office before pool use is allowed.
- If the playground and multi-purpose room are used, then the visiting church must provide responsible supervision while in use.
- Visiting churches to the camp must provide their own paper and cleaning products.
- If a visiting church has arranged to use a cabin of an Association church then it is the visiting churches responsibility to coordinate key handoff and winterizing.
- Camp will be used on Sunday only for worship during traditional worship hours and only appropriately at other times on Sunday and Wednesday evenings during Church prayer meeting or Bible Study.
- Visiting churches will not be allowed to use any cabins unless coordinated with the church which owns it. If cabin are used or disturbed without proper permission from owners then the church group will be asked to leave immediately and will lose their deposit.
- The gate will be closed at 10:00 pm.
- No loitering will be permitted on the grounds.
- No unauthorized vehicles including ATV's will be permitted on the grounds.
- No alcoholic beverages or use of tobacco products will be permitted on the grounds.
- Visiting churches are asked to leave the campgrounds and buildings in the same condition as they found them, including properly disposing of trash in the proper containers.
- No fireworks or firearms allowed on campgrounds.
- Please refrain from being on the ditch bank.
