Prior to coming to Midwestern, Dr. Yeats served as Senior Pastor of Normandale Baptist Church in Fort Worth, TX and as a professor of Church History at Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary. Dr. Yeats loves the local church and served in a variety of ministry roles in churches in the Midwest and Texas. He finds his greatest joy in writing, teaching, and expositional preaching.

Dr. Yeats earned his Ph.D. in Church History from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School in 2004. He also has degrees from Southern Seminary, Oxford University and Criswell College. He has authored three books, *Franchising McChurch: Feeding our Obsession with Easy Christianity* (David C. Cook, 2009), *The Time is Come: The Rise of British Missions to the Jews, 1808-1818* (Lambert, 2009), and *Worldviews: Think for Yourself about how We See God* (NavPress, 2006). He has contributed articles to multiple journals, *The SBC and the 21st Century* (B&H 2016), and the *Encyclopedia of Christian Civilization*.

Dr. Yeats enjoys encouraging congregations and speaks to youth camps, college groups, and churches. He also enjoys consulting with congregations to help them realize their full potential in Christ as they seek to maximize their outreach for the Kingdom.

Dr. Yeats married his wife, Angie, in 1999. They have four incredible kids – Briley, Sean, Cadie and Jackson - that range in age from 11-14. Angie serves alongside John Mark by encouraging young women and young mothers. After dealing with infertility issues and the joys and trials of adoption, she loves to share the hope that can be found in Christ – even in situations that seem hopeless. She graduated from Oklahoma Baptist University with a degree in Early Childhood Education in 1996.
