The reason for the biblical prohibitions (against homosexual behavior in the first century) is the same reason why modern loving homosexual partnerships must also be condemned,

namely that they are incompatible with God's created order (heterosexual monogamy). And since that order was established by creation not culture, its validity is both permanent and universal.

## Genesis 1:27

So God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

### Matthew 19:4-6

"Haven't you read," He replied, "that at the beginning the Creator 'made them male and female,' and said, 'For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife,

and the two will become one flesh'? So they are no longer two, but one.

Therefore what God has joined together, let man not separate."

Same-sex sexual behavior is "unnatural," meaning it violates God's divine design given at Creation.

The people addressed here are attracted to each other; therefore challenging the argument that samesex relationship addressed in the Bible are only abusive and exploitative.

Same-sex sexual behavior is presented as a reflection of an overall idolatrous mindset (v. 25).



Even has a warning for those who encourage and support same-sex sexual behavior (v. 32).



## 1 Corinthians 6:9-10

Do you not know that the wicked will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: Neither the sexually immoral nor idolaters nor adulterers nor male prostitutes nor

homosexual offenders nor thieves nor the greedy nor drunkards nor slanderers nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God.
