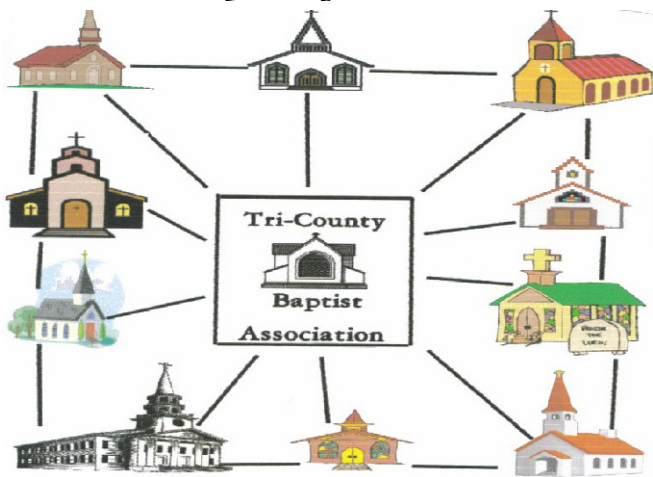

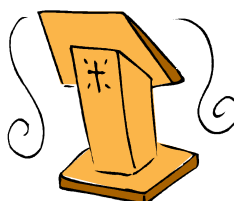

I AM FOR MISSIONS: I think the Cooperative Program (as far as missions support goes) is the best thing since sliced bread. I am excited every time I hear of one of our churches taking a mission trip overseas, around the country or across the state, that's what God has called us to do, but let us not neglect one of the most fertile fields I'm aware of. It is right here in our own Association, the Tri-County Baptist Camp.



During the 2009 camping season more than 2,400 people were involved in various activities on our campground and over 100 of them made a profession of faith. Small improvements are being made on the grounds continually but the greatest need we have, is a new Worship Center.

The Executive Board voted earlier this year to allow us to proceed with plans to build, with the stipulation, that we build debt free. Since June 1, we have raised \$10,481.74. We need to raise, \$100,000.00. The Arkansas Baptist State Convention is promoting and encouraging us to reach Generation Now (older children and youth) that's what we are doing on our campground and you can be a part of it. HOW? By making a one time donation, monthly contributions, or encouraging your church to receive a love offering once a month and donating it to the Camp Building Fund.

Anything you can do will help further the Kingdom, as we continue to reach kids and teens through the ministry of the Tri-County Baptist Camp.

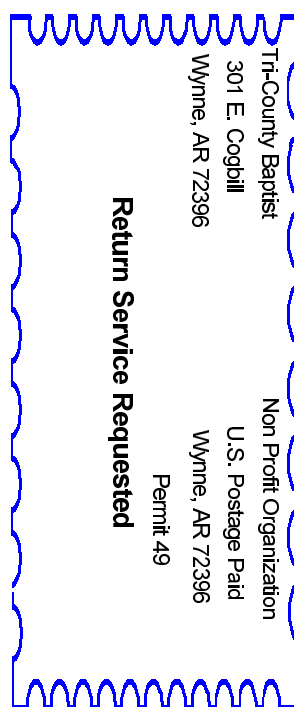
