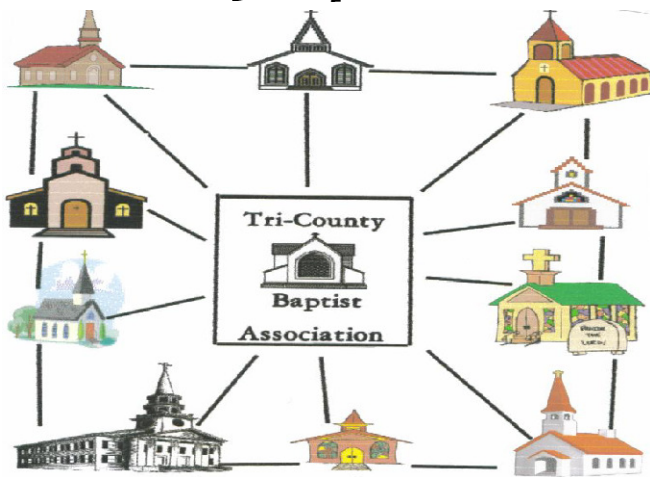

Have you taken a drive up through northern Arkansas or at least seen pictures of the ice-storm that so recently devastated that part of our state? Many described it as looking as if a bomb exploded. In some communities there was hardly a tree left undamaged.

We in the Tri-County area have much to be thankful for, as few, if any of us were affected to any great extent by the storm. But several volunteers of our two Associational Disaster Relief Teams were affected, as they saw first hand the devastation and labored to assist those, whose houses and vehicles were damaged or blocked by fallen trees and limbs and feeding those who were unable to feed themselves for whatever reason.

Our Chainsaw Recovery Unit spent several days in Corning, Ark., assisting more than 36 families. Our Feeding Unit was set up in Jonesboro, Ark., preparing hundreds of meals that were then distributed by the American Red Cross in the surrounding communities.

These God fearing, People loving, volunteers deserve our gratitude, as they have represented our Association well, working at the front lines during this and many other disasters. 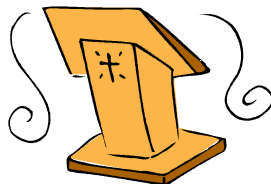

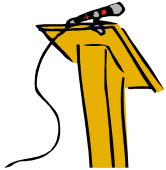

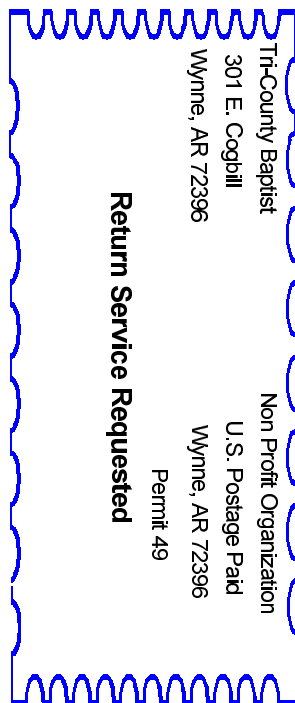
