From the Desk of the DOM

We sing it every Christmas season. It is, arguably, the most beloved of carols. It is *Joy to the World* and it brings out the best in those who participate in any vocal rendition of it. No doubt the text of this hymn is given to praise for our Lord Jesus. Yet it is only one of approximately 750 hymns written by English lyricist/composer, Isaac Watts.

One that seems particularly applicable to our social situation (define that term as you will) today is *O God*, *Our Help in Ages Past*. I can remember singing this as a boy. The tune, written by William Croft in 1708, and the text, based on Psalm 90 and written by Watts in 1708 as well, were married sometime later in the 18th century to become a well-known hymn of praise to God.

According to author Robert J. Morgan in *Then Sings My Soul, Special Edition, "*It was played on the radio by the BBC as soon as World War II was declared". In fact, the message of this hymn has offered comfort and hope in the face of trials for centuries; and no wonder with lyrics such as:

O God, our help in ages past, Our hope for years to come, Our shelter from the stormy blast, And our eternal home.

Under the shadow of Thy throne Thy saints have dwelt secure; Sufficient is Thine arm alone, And our defense is sure.

O God, our help in ages past, Our hope for years to come, Be Thou our guard while troubles last, And our eternal home.

There are six more verses just as poignant as these! The lyrics in these verses have not changed. Psalm 90 has not changed and, therefore, the Biblical truth in the lyrics has not changed. Certainly Almighty God has not changed! There is, then, absolutely no reason this hymn cannot offer the same comfort and hope today.



"HATE MAIL" 2 Kings 19:14-19

Letters can be wonderful, notes of encouragement, birth announcements, wedding invitations, or they can be devastating, like a notice of the passing of a loved one or a termination letter. I remember my mother telling me about finding out that her father had died three months after the fact because she was serving in the jungles of Venezuela.

In this passage we are looking at today, Hezekiah received hate mail from Sennacherib in the form of a letter demanding complete surrender. Let's look at a couple points that need to be made:

I. HEZEKIAH RECIEVED THE LETTER AFTER DOING THE RIGHT THING

He had reestablished the temple worship and the Passover among other things and yet hate mail. The bible says ALL who live godly SHALL suffer persecution. Here is where it gets good: the devil can't keep us out of heaven but he CAN keep us discouraged and thereby useless to God.

So he sends us hate mail in the form of lies, such as you can't be forgiven, or things will never change, or prayer is useless, or you're not good enough, or God is not good, or there is no one to help you. Jesus said about Satan: "When he tells a lie, he speaks from his own nature, because he is a liar and the father of liars."

Joshua challenged the people in his day with these words: "...choose for yourselves today the one you will worship... As for me and my family, we will worship Yahweh." Joshua 24:15

II. AFTER RECEIVING THE LETTER, HEZEKIAH PRESENTED IT TO GOD

"Hezekiah took the letter from the hand of the messengers, read it, then went up to the LORD's temple, and spread it out before the LORD." 2 Kings 19:14

Every one of the lies Satan tells us, need to be brought to the throne of grace so that we may find help in time of need. Ask yourself, what does God's Word say about this?

He prayed a powerful prayer to the Lord.

- -He mentioned God's POWER "You made the heavens and the earth."
- -He mentioned the PROBLEM "Hear the words that Sennacherib has sent to mock the living God."
- -He mentioned his POSITION "...LORD our God, please save us from his hand."
- -He mentioned God's PURPOSE "...all the kingdoms of the earth may know that You are the LORD God—You alone."

The bible reminds us to "Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God, so that He may exalt you at the proper time, casting all your care on Him, because He cares about you." 1Peter 5:6&7

When Hezekiah sought the Lord, God answered in a mighty way through the prophet Isaiah:

"Therefore, this is what the LORD says about the king of Assyria: He will not enter this city or shoot an arrow there or come before it with a shield or build up an assault ramp against it. He will go back on the road that he came and he will not enter this city." 2 Kings 19:32, 33

When we seek the Lord, He will answer us, too!

What an incredible Collection Week we had this year! In spite of the pandemic,



The Naivasha Children's Shelter in Naivasha, Kenya, provides a safe place for boys who would otherwise be living on the dangerous streets. The shelter workers seek to reunite them with their families.

Day 2



Monday, November 30

In an area of Croatia with 250,000 people and only one Baptist church, Eric Maronev works with a team to broadcast an evangelistic program, which airs twice a week and reaches more than 40,000 people.

Day 3



Tuesday, December 1

Doug Derbyshire has been faithfully visiting Baan Po as a medical missionary for the last six years. After trying every evangelism technique he knew, there was still no church in Baan Po. His last visit in January 2020 sparked new hope as three patients made decisions of faith.

Day 4



Wednesday, December 2

Farmers harvest fish from a pond built to provide a sustainable livelihood for 11 indigenous missionary families. IMB missionary Joe Brewster and his team partner with indigenous missionaries in Peru to engage unreached tribes with the gospel.

Day 5



Thursday, December 3

Throughout their 175year history, Southern Baptists have maintained an uninterrupted witness among the nations, in spite of famine, war and civil unrest. This commitment has not come without sacrifice.

Day 6



Friday, December 4

Working alongside Italian and US partners, the Worthys bring the gospel to areas of Italy with little to no evangelical witness by strategically placing partnering groups in areas of Italy where churches do not exist.

Day 7



Saturday, December 5

For 20 years, the IMB worked to maintain a gospel presence among the Khaleela, a Muslim people group in South Asia. After years of setbacks, Luciano and Sofia Serrano moved to the region and are now discipling a woman from the Khaleela who decided to follow Christ.

Day 8



Sunday, December 6

IMB missionaries say thank you to Southern Baptists who give generously so that the gospel spreads to all nations.
