I am very excited and happy to announce that the Great Physician's Pharmacy has been inspected and officially approved by the State Board of Pharmacy. The state inspector came last Tuesday, May 12, and gave the Bryan Baptist Association the go ahead to begin this new ministry. The essential purpose will be twofold: meet pharmaceutical needs for those who cannot afford their much needed medications, and, most of all, minister to spiritual needs. This is a unique way to get into the hearts of people, especially those who are otherwise indifferent to the gospel. The Scripture teaches us to become all things to all people, so that we might by all means save some (I Cor.9:22).

Karen Horn of First Baptist Colbert will direct this ministry. Committee members are: Cara Lindsay, Monica Thornton, Deborah Horn, Carol Gray, Sally Ashley, Jerry and Quinna Lewis. There is already a host of people who have stepped up to volunteer. Several pharmacists have graciously consented to help. The place of operation will be at the Assistance Center of Bryan Co - 1303 Waco St. (the old health department building). It will be open one night a week. We will need 8 to 10 volunteers to help each time.

Our grand opening will probably be sometime in June when we collect an adequate amount of meds to begin operation. Many more volunteers are needed. Please call Karen at 580-434-2379 or the BBA office if you want to help. Please pray that God will use this ministry in a wonderful way.
