From the desk of the DOM

Mrs. Denise George, wife of Dr. Timothy George, Dean of the Beeson School of Divinity, has written an excellent book entitled WHAT PASTORS WISH CHURCH MEMBERS KNEW. I wish this book could be read by many church members. Few of us really stop to sincerely consider what kind of struggles and anxieties pastors and staff experience. Because of fear of embarrassment, loss of support, being misunderstood and a number of other reasons they tend not to tell. Mrs. George, in conducting a survey with 400 clergymen representing more than 40 denominations, discovered the following facts:

- Pastors/staff are often lonely and in need of close friends and encouragement. There are few, if any, true friends they can trust enough to share their struggles and hurts.
- They want to feel needed in their congregations.
- Like every other human, they possess personal inadequacies and limitations.
- They aren't immune to life's problems or personal fears.
- They get discouraged and experience self-doubt.
- They need understanding, acceptance and support just like their church members.
- They can be hurt by criticism, insensitivity or lack of appreciation.
 Because their families live in "glass houses" they are sometimes hurt deeply by unfair criticism.
- They sometimes get angry.
- They often struggle to live up to expectations that are sometimes unrealistic and impossible to fulfill.
- They don't possess every spiritual gift. Some areas of ministry may be difficult for them.

Have you told your pastor/staff lately how much you love and appreciate them? Take time often to encourage them and their families. Invite them to dinner. Give them a special gift. Listen to their hurts and concerns. Show them that they can trust you. Affirm and celebrate their work. Complement them for their giftedness and refrain from criticism. One of the best ways is to find your place of usefulness in the church. Work hard and watch them rejoice. Let them know that you pray regularly for them.
