Vikki Franks, a missionary from Poland, wrote that she enjoys helping distribute OCC shoeboxes. She said Baptists are often regarded as a cult in Poland and shoebox distribution opens doors. When missionaries give boxes, they tell Bible stories and the kids act them out. Entire families are present.

Vikki met a young couple who had become Christians by watching Bible lessons on the internet. They were looking for a Baptist church. They offered to help with shoeboxes. The woman immediately recognized the boxes! When she was in the 1st grade, she received a box with a note tucked inside!

Much later, she was excited to help spread God's Word through OCC. Vikki believes receiving the shoebox helped open the door to salvation for the young woman.

Packing a box and praying for the child who receives it is a real mission opportunity. Teachers, bring blank note cards and let your class members hand print notes to put in boxes.

Don't include toothpaste, candy, toy weapons, liquids, medicines, foods, or anything breakable: instead, send a note and do pray!
