# St. Mark's Lutheran Church Scholarship

## Bloomfield, Nebraska)

(Approved by St. Mark's Church Council: November 23, 2014)

Information regarding the scholarship fund, guidelines for application, and award.

- A. This scholarship shall be called the "St. Mark's Evangelical Lutheran Scholarship."
- B. The Scholarship Committee is composed of three members appointed by the church council. It is the responsibility of the Scholarship Committee to review the scholarship applications submitted by the designated deadline and to select the recipients.
- C. The St. Mark's Lutheran Church Council will set the amount of the scholarship(s) awarded. The number of scholarships will be determined by funds available with consideration of accrued interest and donations received.
- D. The awarded scholarships will be presented to the student(s) at the St. Mark's Lutheran Church Annual Meeting. The awarded scholarship(s) will be paid to the student(s).
- E. Applications for the scholarship may be secured by visiting or emailing with the Scholarship Committee Chairperson or on the church website.
- F. **The Scholarship Committee Chairperson must receive by the church office or applications before 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 17, 2017.**
- G. Those eligible for the scholarship must be:
  - A. A member of St. Mark's Evangelical Lutheran Church.
  - B. Presently accepted or attending a post-secondary school.
  - C. Prior recipients may reapply; but, new applicants will be considered first.
- H. Qualifications for this scholarship will be:
  - A. Student must have completed/or will be completing the fall semester and be enrolled in the spring semester of the same school year.
  - B. The completed application must be received by the designated deadline.
  - C. Student must submit a copy of the student's spring semester schedule showing student is enrolled for the spring semester and showing the college the student is attending.
