Azusa Street Prophecies

When the Revival begin to wind down about 1910, there were two prophecies from Azusa Street. In the Last Days three things will happen to the Pentecostal Movement.

The Prophecies that came out of the Azusa Street Revival around 1910: They predicted the apostasy of the Pentecostal movement, it also predicted the falling away of those who once believed.

- 1. The over emphasis on power, instead of righteousness.
- 2. An over emphasis on praise to a God they no longer pray to.
- 3. An over emphasis on the gifts of the spirit, instead of the lordship of Jesus Christ.

The Prophecies that came out of the Azusa Street Revival: They predicted the apostasy of the Pentecostal movement, it also predicted the falling away of those who once believed.

<u>Prophecy 2</u> – It came from a book called "They told me their stories" the author went around and got the stories of the children of Azusa street, one person that he interviewed said that he remembered at the close of the revival in 1910. William Seymour stood up and said "100 years from now, there will come a revival that will make this one look pale in comparison."
