

HE HATH TURNED MY SORROW INTO DANCING

Psa 30:11 Thou hast turned for me my mourning into dancing: thou hast put off my sackcloth, and girded me with gladness;

Psa 30:12 To the end that *my* glory may sing praise to thee, and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give thanks unto thee forever.

Ecc 3:4 A time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, **and a time to dance;**

Psa 30:11

Thou hast turned for me - In my behalf. That is, God had heard his prayer; he had brought his troubles to an end; he had caused his sorrows to be succeeded by correspondent joy.

Psa 30:11 Those hast turned for me my mourning into dancing,....Sometimes our mourning by reason of sin, their own and others; or on account of afflictions; or because of spiritual decays; or through the temptations of Satan; or, as it was the case of the psalmist now, because of the hidings of God's face; but this mourning is exchanged for joy and gladness when the Lord discovers his pardoning love, revives his work in their souls, takes off his afflicting hand from them, rebukes the tempter, and delivers out of his temptations, and shows himself, his grace and favour;

Psa 139:17 How precious also are thy thoughts unto me, O God! how great is the sum of them!

Psa 139:18 *If* I should count them, they are more in number than the sand: when I awake, I am still with thee.

Psa 139:17

How precious also are thy thoughts unto me, O God! - The remark is made here doubtless in view of the numberless "thoughts" involved in planning and forming a frame, and our future, so wondrous, and in the care necessary to bring it to perfection; to develop it; to provide for it; to guard and defend it. How many "thoughts" of a parent are employed in behalf of his children, in providing for them; teaching them; counseling them; anticipating their needs. How many more thoughts are needful on the part of God in reference to each one of us: for there are numberless things necessary for us which cannot occupy

the mind of a parent, since he cannot accomplish these things for us; they do not lie within his province, or in his power.

Psa 126:1 When the LORD turned again the captivity of Zion, we were like them that dream.

Psa 126:2 Then was our mouth filled with laughter, and our tongue with singing: then said they among the heathen, The LORD hath done great things for them.

Psea 126:3 The LORD hath done great things for us; *whereof* we are glad.

Psa 126:4 Turn again our captivity, O LORD, as the streams in the south.

Psa 126:5 They that sow in tears shall reap in joy.

Psa 126:6 He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves *with him*.

The Word turned Again: (Strong's)

1. Recall; Recompense; recover; refresh, rescue; restore; retrieve; reverse; take back.
2. Sometimes what may look like a setback and turn around and be a set up for God to work a miracle in your life.
3. We can use negative situations as a stepping stone to greater victory.

JESUS ARE PRIME EXAMPLE

1. **Through the death on the cross;** Jesus took sin and misery and brought joy unspeakable and full of glory.
2. He brought sickness and brought healing and rejoicing
3. He took impossible situations and brought hope
4. He took death and brought live everlasting

Isa 61:3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

1. Turned a marriage supper into new wine
2. Turned a leper into a next door neighbor
3. Turned a lame man into a productive citizen
4. Turned a thief into a giving person (four fold will I return)
5. Turned a demon possessed person into a faithful disciple (Mary Magdalene)
6. Turned a funeral procession into a victory march
7. Turned a barren women into a housekeeper
8. Turned a immoral woman into a saint of God
9. Turned a demon possessed man that wore not clothed and broke every chain the society tried to bind him with into a person clothed and in his right mind sitting at the feet of Jesus.
10. Took a deaf and dumb person and made it possible that he could read and write and speak clearly.

The Lord is My Shepherd:

Psa 23:1 The LORD *is* my shepherd; I shall not want.

Psa 23:2 He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters.

Psa 23:3 He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

Psa 23:4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou *art* with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.

Psa 23:5 Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.

Psa 23:6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

Psa 8:3 When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which thou hast ordained;

Psa 8:4 What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him?

Psa 8:5 For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour.

Psa 8:6 Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all *things* under his feet:

Psa 8:7 All sheep and oxen, yea, and the beasts of the field;

Psa 8:8 The fowl of the air, and the fish of the sea, *and whatsoever* passeth through the paths of the seas.

Psa 8:9 O LORD our Lord, how excellent *is* thy name in all the earth!

Php 4:19 But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Son 2:10 My beloved spake, and said unto me, Rise up, my love, my fair one, and come away.

Son 2:11 For, lo, the winter is past, the rain is over *and* gone;

Son 2:12 The flowers appear on the earth; the time of the singing *of birds* is come, and the voice of the turtle is heard in our land;

Son 2:13 The fig tree putteth forth her green figs, and the vines *with* the tender grape give a *good* smell. Arise, my love, my fair one, and come away.

Son 2:14 O my dove, *that art* in the clefts of the rock, in the secret *places* of the stairs, let me see thy countenance, let me hear thy voice; for sweet *is* thy voice, and thy countenance *is* comely.

Psa 30:5 For his anger *endureth but* a moment; in his favour *is* life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy *cometh* in the morning.

Rev 5:9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

Rev 5:10 And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.
