

## Your Sense of Taste

Have you ever thought about why foods taste different? It's really quite amazing. Your tongue and the roof of your mouth are covered with thousands of tiny taste buds. When you eat something, the saliva in your mouth helps break down your food. This causes the receptor cells located in your taste buds to send messages through sensory nerves to your brain. Your brain then tells you what flavors you are tasting.



Taste buds probably play the most important part in helping you enjoy the many flavors of food. Your taste buds can recognize four basic kinds of tastes: sweet, salty, sour, and bitter. The salty/sweet taste buds are located near the front of your tongue; the sour taste buds line the sides of your tongue; and the bitter taste buds are found at the very back of your tongue.

Everyone's tastes are different. In fact, your tastes will change as you get older. When you were a baby, you had taste buds, not only on your tongue, but on the sides and roof of your mouth. This means you were very sensitive to different foods. As you grew, the taste buds began to disappear from the sides and roof of your mouth, leaving taste buds mostly on your tongue. As you get older, your taste buds will become even less sensitive, so you will be more likely to eat foods that you thought were too strong as a child.

## TONGUES IS MAN'S GREATEST EXPRESSION

1. The tongue is man's greatest expression. Man is a spiritual creature; he is emotional. Because he is emotional, he must give expression to these emotions. The ability and power to co=ordinate thought and tongue into intelligent speech is one of the highest prerogatives of man. This elevates him above the beast of the field. This makes him superior to any of God's creation. This is the most distinguishing feature of his being. The tongue becomes the vehicle of expression for your spirit. All of the emotions, such as love, hate, anger, sorrow, joy, happiness, relief, and serenity are communicated through the tongue. It is the gateway to your heart, your feelings, your feelings, your spirit and attitudes.
2. All these things being true, it is not difficult to see why god would use the speaking in tongues to express the greatest, most wonderful experience that mortal man could receive. In the baptism of the Holy Ghost, **His Spirit and yours become one**. It is a wonder of wonders, chosen not by man, but by God, the sovereign ruler of the universe.
