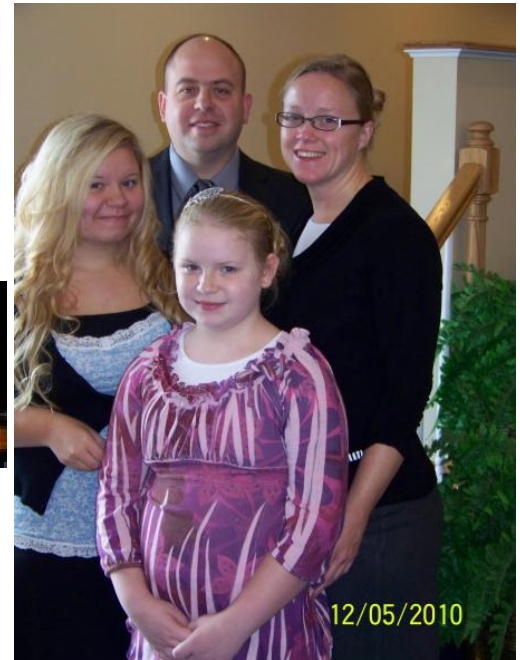

Thank you for your willingness to accept my burden and lighten my load.

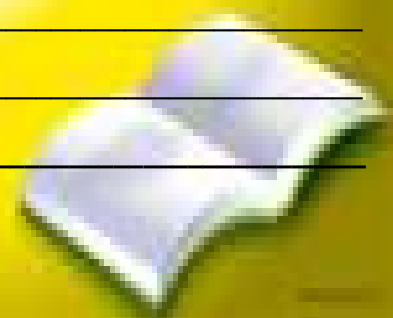
