YOUTH MINISTER JOB DESCRIPTION & POLICY

I. Objectives of Youth Program

- A. To win lost youth to Jesus Christ, Church membership and to help them grow spiritually.
- B. To develop and strengthen the youth educational program of the church (Sunday School, Church Training, Mission's Education and Teaching Improvement)
- C. To provide counsel for youth in matters related to their spiritual life, the choice of college, the selection of vocation, life mate, social and family relationships.
- D. To provide the youth with Christian fellowship and recreation.
- E. To provide the youth with a strong foundation in the Christian Faith and in Southern Baptist beliefs.

II. Principle of Function

The Minister of youth is responsible to the Pastor and the Church body for planning, coordinating, directing and evaluating the youth educational ministry of the church.

RESPNSIBILITIES

- A. Direct planning, conducting and evaluating of comprehensive youth program, taking into consideration the spiritual, physical, recreational, social and psychological development of youth.
- B. Direct the biblical education program for the youth in consultation with the Minister of Education (S. S. Dir. & D. T. Dir.)
- C. Work with youth workers to plan a program for leading youth to knowledge of the plan of salvation and to nurture them in their Christian development.
- D. Assist organizational leaders in the enlistment, training and guidance of youth workers to achieve the purposes of the church youth education.
- E. Lead in planning and conducting special youth activities and programs appropriate for the spiritual growth of the youth of the church including Falls Creek, YEC, Retreats, Camps, Mission Trips etc...
- F. Coordinate the work of the Youth with Music, Activities and other Programs
- G. Promote a regular visitation program for youth and or in coordination with the overall church outreach programs.
- H. Participate in Church visitation programs, and any hospital and crisis visitation that is connected with the youth.

- I. Study and make any recommendations for needed changes in the Youth Dept. Such as organizational changes, space changes, furniture & equipment changes, policies & procedure of operation changes
- J. With the Youth Committee, prepare the annual budget proposal to be submitted to the Stewardship Committee
- K. Study & make recommendation on all educational curriculum.
- L. Present a report before the church at Church Council and the regular monthly Business Meetings
- M. Visit local school (Jr. H.S./Mid. School and H.S.) campuses for personal contact with students at school approved times.
- N. Maintain one-to-one contact with individual students and parents.
- O. Endeavor to help the students be sensitive to God's call on their life and to their full time vocation in the ministry.
- P. Encourage and challenge the youth to be active in ALL Worship, Bible Study and Church Activities.
- Q. Coordinate and administer all athletic and recreational programs.
- R. Drive the church van when needed.
- S. Perform any other duties as the Pastor assigns.

OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Attend staff Meetings, Sunday School and Church Council Meetings
- 2. Insure that an adequate number of adult sponsors are present for all youth programs and activities.
- 3. Participate in Worship services as directed by the Pastor.

III. RELATIONSHIPS

A. Pastor

The Youth Minister will be responsible to the Pastor and the Church body]

- 1. Will coordinate all dates and activities with the church calendar
- 2. Will seek counsel and advice on programs and activities
- 3. Will coordinate vacation times (absences for Vacation and Revival are two Sundays per year for each cause. Thus a total of four during the church calendar year.

B. Volunteer Workers

The Youth Minister will enlist and ensure background checks, motivate, train, and supervise all volunteers in the Youth programs

C. Will work with cooperation and through the Youth Committee

V. PERSONAL CONDUCT

A. ALL behavior, whether during a church activities or personal time is to be Christ-Like.
