REMINDER TO ELECT MESSENGERS
 According to our Constitution, Messengers must be elected and names entered in the ACP prior to October 8, 2018
 ARTICLE III— SECTION II. Messengers and Reports states:
 (a) Each church shall be entitled to three (3) messengers, and one (1) additional messenger for each 50 members or fraction thereof, provided no church shall have more than ten (10) messengers. Only those whose names appear on the Annual Church Profile (ACP) from the churches shall be considered messengers.
 (b) Each church shall make an annual report to the Association. It shall give names of its messengers, the names of the church officers, financial condition and statistics of the church as shown by the Annual Church Profile (ACP) furnished by the State Convention and any other information of value to report to the Association or which is requested by the Association. Annual Church Profiles (ACP) are to be filed with the Associational office or the SBC Workspace online no later than two weeks before the Annual Meeting.
