Director of Missions.....

Dear Bowen Baptist Association Family and Friends Beyond:

It is a pleasure to begin growing in Christlikeness with you. From the time the search committee asked me to complete an in-depth questionnaire last fall, through the interview and voting process, my wife Brenda and I have rejoiced in the faith of those who have worked with us and issued my call to work with and among you. The search team pastors, Reverends Jimmy Dean, Steve Poppell, David Williams, Michael Wingertsahn, and Chairman Conrad Salter are passionate about living out the Great Commission.

Our Moderator Dr. Ernie Jones, whom we have known for quite a few years, has served above and beyond the call of duty as our Interim Director of Missions. He has also been a boon for me as I settle in. And I could not leave out Mrs. Mary Anna Chapman, our Ministry Assistant. That young lady lives up to her title. She so wonderfully loves serving our Lord through the Bowen office, and will continue to do so with fervor.

Brenda and I are visiting among our forty-one churches and are enjoying meeting our pastors and people. Of course, it will take time visiting on Sundays and Wednesdays in order to be in every church, but we will, and we will also see one another during associational events. Pastors, please keep us informed of your needs, of your joys, and of your personal and ministry events (revivals, homecomings, mission trips, etc.). Call, text, and/or email me at any time. Through our almost twenty-nine years of marriage, and my thirty plus years as a pastor, serving our Lord through His church has been our call and our passion. We have been actively involved in each of the four associations where I have served as pastor and prayerfully trust Christ as we serve you, and work alongside you.
