At this newsletter's production, Brenda and I are with the Blairsville Mission Trip and the first night of VBS at Ebenezer was tonight. This morning, we participated in their Homecoming worship, and it has been a glorious day up here in the mountains. Of course, every day is a glorious day when you know Christ! Amen? Amen!

There are so many things I would like to tell you, and two of those are going on this week – Blairsville VBS and the Annual Meeting of the SBC in Nashville (not GA) – so those updates will have to wait until later. However, let me tell you about four others.

- 1) Our **Bowen Women's Ministry** will hold their quarterly meeting at New Fountainhead on Thursday, July 8th. Mrs. Kathryn Mejia-Collins will be their guest, and she will share about the Servolution that each of our 41 churches has been invited to do on Saturday, November 20th. Our Bowen Women's Ministry Director, Mrs. Leanne Guest, will say more about that. (We look forward to resuming our Men's Ministry as soon as we have a leader in place.)
- 2) Our **Alpha Pregnancy Center** is on hiatus until reopening on Tuesday, September 14th due to an Alpha-wide slowdown of patients and the need to train new volunteers. We need ladies as volunteers at the Southwest GA center in Donalsonville, and we need you urgently. A full listing of volunteer opportunities with job descriptions is being sent to each church. The center is open on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, and the more volunteers we have, the easier it is to staff. The Alpha center in Albany will interview and train all volunteers.
