Dear Bowen Baptist Association and Friends Beyond:

It is interesting how certain "catch-phrases" that we have read or heard over time can pop into our thoughts. In our days of constant information input, we are presented with advertisements sporting pithy bylines; movies and television shows which touch our emotions with clever ways of saying ordinary things; sermons, songs, and saints who have worded our faith walk in picturesque language; etc.

One such phrase for me came from one of my seminary professors in New Orleans. Dr. Joe Cothen often reminded us to "Stay Fresh". He wanted us "preacher boys" (as he so respectfully called us) to be so in tune with Christ that sermons would be fresh from our experience with the Master. Another professor assigned us a Bible-reading plan that corresponded with my preaching class in a perfect way.

Dr. Thiele required us to have a three-part reading plan. Part one: A Daily Devotional reading for inspiration. Part two: A Focused reading such as reading through a book of the Bible over a week's time. And Part three: A Sermonizing reading where we focused on Scripture the Holy Spirit impressed upon us, which caused us to make notes for the purpose of creating a sermon. Those two professors knew that we preacher boys couldn't proclaim the Word from a dry-walk in Christ. Not only did we have to read in those three ways, but we had to make notes from our readings and submit those for a grade. One old-timer said that what's in the well comes up in the bucket.

Every time preachers step into the pulpit, or teachers teach, or music leaders lead, we are proclaiming what the Lord has dealt with us about days and weeks earlier. The challenge for us all is to Stay Fresh! Read. Study. Pray. Ask Christ for Wisdom and Discernment. That is what Paul wrote to a young preacher boy at the First Baptist Church of Ephesus: Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly diving the Word of Truth. (II Timothy 3:16)

Read earthly writings secondarily and read them through the eyes of Christ. Dr. Billy Graham always read the newspapers wherever in the world he preached revivals. He did so in order to use familiar happenings as illustrations in his messages that would connect the people with God's Word.

Life is certainly busy and satan doesn't want us in the Word, but in order for us to know Him, we must do all we can to spend time in His Word. The Bible is the Lord's revelation of Himself to us. May we read when we are tired, read at work on break, read at school during recess, read in the waiting room, read on vacation, and read while the preacher/teacher is leading. May we Stay Fresh in the Word.
