Retired United Methodist pastor Mike Slaughter reminds us that "Christmas Is Not Your Birthday." He encourages us to ask the question, "What would Jesus want for his birthday?"

Christmas reminds us that Jesus is the embodiment of the one the prophet Isaiah called Emmanuel—which means God with us.

God is with us always and forever—even during a pandemic.


