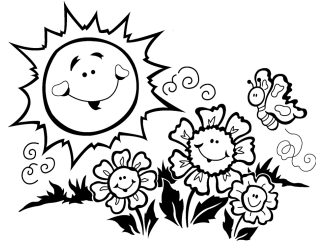

Vacation Bible School Craft Needs

This year's VBS theme is Adventure of the Treasure Seekers. There will be 5 days of different crafts focusing on these main ideas for children: God loves you, God knows you, God treasures you, God forgives you and God is with you. Our objective at First Presbyterian is to encourage children to discover the love of God and Jesus Christ and God's promises to us. If you have any of the following craft supplies at home or any that you would be willing to contribute, the VBS crew would greatly appreciate them. We are praying that we can reach as many as 40 children in our community, so please pray with us as we anticipate a fun and meaningful ministry.

Large die-cut foam letters and shapes (these often come in tubs)
White craft glue bottles
Clean Styrofoam meat trays and plastic bowls

Any type of ribbon (fabric or otherwise)
Assorted buttons, beads, rick-rack, colored plastic jewels
Jumbo craft (popsicle) sticks
Any colors of craft paint (opened bottles are fine)
Craft paint brushes (foam and regular)
Magnetic tape
Different varieties of macaroni and dried beans (these can be already opened bags)
Washable markers
Felt squares of various colors (9"x 12")
Unused paint stir sticks
Gold spray paint
Empty toilet paper rolls
Dowel rods (3/16" to 1/4" in diameter). These will be cut into 12" lengths.
